Through this involvement, Cramer was invited to join the Planned Parenthood of Chester County (PPCC) Board of Directors in August 2006. After a year of serving on the Board, Cramer was elected to the Executive Committee to serve as Secretary of the PPCC Board. Cramer was selected to serve on the Planned Parenthood Federation of America Eastern Region's Emerging Leaders Task Force in August of 2007.

During college Cramer worked for the president of FSGP as her Administrative Assistant. Upon beginning work for founder and President, Margaret Downey, Cramer was "enlightened" to find a definition for her philosophical stance.
